## Daily Check:

1. Check fuel level.
2. Run saw.

## Weekly Check:

1. Visually inspect saw for any needed repairs.
2. Run for two (2) minutes.

## Fuel:

Gas/Oil Mixture per manufacturer's recommendations.

Clean all spilled fuel from saw before starting.

## Cleaning and Maintenance:

1. Keep the chain, bar, and sprocket clean and lubricated.
2. Keep the chain sharp.
3. Keep the chain at proper tension; tighten all nuts, bolts and screws (except the carburetor screws) adjustment after each use.
4. Keep spark plug and wire connection tight and clean.

Safety:

1. Always wear hearing, eye, head and glove protection as a minimum requirement.

NOTE: B58, W58 and S57 have CHAPS.
